b) **Section 106 monies** – MPC had sought permission to use Section 106 monies for a grass running track around inside perimeter of the Rec but Marsworth fell into Rural Parish 2 in the Sport and Leisure Facilities matrix and approval could not be granted. It was resolved that the Clerk should seek quotations for a grass track which would be paid for by MPC.

c) **Recreation ground flooding** as Brook is over-flowing. Clerk to obtain quotations for work to be carried out.

d) **Footpath from Marsworth to Pitstone.** Consider maintenance issues. Clerk to obtain quotation from Jez Leonard to clear the path in a similar way to that of the Access Path at the Recreation Ground.

e) **Pitstone Junior Youth Football Team:** Richard Wade (Gurney's Farm) will be using the Rec on Wednesday evenings for the junior football team in Pitstone. Previously agreed Min No 19/1129(c).

f) **Marsworth Fun Run on 8th May.** It was resolved that the Recreation Ground could be used for the Fun Run.
