22/08/03 Public Participation: Discussion took place in relation to Ainscough's proposed Marsworth Airfield development.

22/08/04 Questions for - and Update from - Buckinghamshire Councillors

Cllr Brazier reported that the Community Board were offering micro-grants of up to £1k for non-profit items for the community such as benches.

No update on White Lion but Section 216 deadline had passed and Peter Brazier would ascertain if all required works had taken place.

Data from HGV Licensing was awaited in relation to Aylesbury Truck Hire at Marsworth Airfield.
