Minutes of meeting held on 14 November 2022 in Millennium Hall, Marsworth at 8.00 pm

22/11/02 Declarations of Interest: None

22/11/03 Public Participation:

- a) Request for Community Garden in Marsworth. The Parish Council were supportive of the proposal and land initially suggested was the triangle opposite the Village Hall or the grass verge at the corner of Lukes Lea and Vicarage Road. Buckinghamshire Council to be approached to ascertain if this is possible.
- b) Speeding issue Lower Icknield Way. A petition had been submitted by residents in Lower Icknield Way regarding speeding issues. In addition to the Speed Indicator Device (SID) sited in Lower Icknield Way, the MVAS (on Ioan from Cheddington PC) had also been installed temporarily by the PC. RK to download the results from both the MVAS and SID prior to the next meeting and the results to be discussed at the next Parish meeting to consider the level of speeding and steps required. Consideration to also be given to ascertaining the level of support from residents to set up a Community Watch initiative.

22/11/04 Questions for - and Update from - Buckinghamshire Councillors.

- The White Lion the planning decision was delayed until after the SAC Chiltern Beechwoods Mitigation Strategy for Ashridge Commons and Woods was determined at the end of January 2023.
- b) Freight Strategy update signage awaited
- 22/11/05 Minutes of Parish Council meeting held on 10 October 2022. It was resolved that the draft minutes were a true and accurate record and the Chairman was duly authorised to sign them on behalf of the Council.
- 22/11/06 Clerk's Report: This section provides updates on on-going issues. Resolutions cannot be passed on items in this section.
 - a) 2 large Pot holes in Watery Lane. Reported (Ref TfB379655391 (18 Nov 21)
 - b) **Gutters and pavements in Lower End**. TfB organising for vegetation to be edged out along pathways (Nov 21). Councillor Town confirmed that this was on TfB's list.

 TfB obtaining a quote from a sub-contractor to carry out some clearance both on the footway and carriageway. (5 Sep 22). Cllr Town to follow this up.
 - c) Failure of footpath at Lower End -The total length of footway between the airfield and the entrance to Aspens Farm would be added to similar schemes to be considered when capital funding was made available for footway surfacing / reconstruction full repair.
 - d) Faded 30mph sign and 30 mph sign hidden in bushes leading from Pitstone to Marsworth TfB had written to the landowner re hedges and TfB would order a replacement for the faded sign (12 August 2022).
 - e) Bridge Weight Restriction obscured at Red Lion Bridge. TfB had contacted the relevant landowners requesting necessary maintenance be carried out in accordance with the Highways Act 1980. (31 Aug 22)
 - f) Garages to be Replaced at The Crescent. Clerk had been advised it was in this year's budget. Cllr Town to let Clerk have the new contact's email address.

21/03229/FUL Startop Farm, Long Barn Lower Icknield Way Marsworth Tring Hertfordshire HP23 4LL Redevelopment of the existing farm complex to enable two replacement farm buildings to be constructed with hard standing, parking areas and new access. Demolition of the existing farm, commercial, and equestrian buildings, and existing single storey bungalow. Construction of 9no dwellings and associated works including parking provision and access. 22/01678/MOA Dacorum and 22/02189/AOP Buckinghamshire. Land at Former Marsworth Airfield. Outline Planning permission for demolition of existing buildings, structures and hardstanding to enable the erection of up to 320 residential (Use Class C3), a primary school, a local centre comprising community facilities (Use Class F2) and a rural enterprise hub (Use Class E) together with a transport mobility hub, public open space, drainage, landscaping and ancillary infrastructure. New vehicular and pedestrian access off Long Marston Road with all other matters (including other means of access) reserved. MPC objected. Over 200 objections. Application withdrawn.

It was noted that Ainscough stated on its website that it will re-apply in 2023. It was agreed to alert residents by posting a notice on the noticeboards, website and Marsworth News.

22/01187/MOA Marshcroft Development - Dacorum Local Plan (2020-2038) Strategy for Growth . Hybrid application (with access details of two main access points from Bulbourne Road and Station road in full and the main development on the rest of the site in outline with all matters reserved) for the demolition of all existing buildings on the site and the development of up to 1,400 dwellings (including up to 140 use class C2 dwellings); a new local centre and sports /community hub, primary school, secondary school, and public open spaces including creation of a suitable alternative natural green space.—App 9 Apr 22. **Refused 10 Oct 22**

- a) Recreation Ground: Equipment inspection by GM nothing to report.. JW to report at December meeting. 22/11/11 Items for Information/Discussion
 - a) Defra guidance re Avian Flu and the collection & identification of dead wild birds. Information on MPC website.
 - b) Buckinghamshire Council is **consulting on Aylesbury Garden Town1**, a site allocation within the VALP. Closing date extended to 30 November 2022.
 - c) Lower Icknield Way speeding issues see 22/11/03 above.
 - d) Non-Authorised car parking at Village Hall car park. Notice to be left on vehicle's windscreen as this was an on-going issue with one vehicle.
 - e) Storage Bin Area near Red Lion Bridge. Request submitted to Canal & River Trust (CRT) for improved signage to deter fly tippers/non-moorings. CRT replied that it felt strongly that increased clean-up operations alone were not a sustainable solution to the problem, a strain on its limited resources, and sent the wrong message to those who regularly disposed of waste. Conversely, it had seen real successes where local communities had adopted a length of canal.
 - f) It was resolved that John Woodruffe would represent MPC as a reader for the 9 Lessons and Carols on Monday 19 December at All Saints Church.
 - g) Salt Bins. It had been reported that a salt bin was missing from the corner of Ship Lane and Long Marston Road. Transport for Bucks (TfB) did not have a record of a bin at that location. A bin was available near the bridge outside the Red Lion pub and whether this was sufficient could be reviewed over the winter.
