Public Participation: None Questions for - and Update from - Buckinghamshire Councillors. 23/02/04

- Community Board Funding for a replacement oven for the Village Hall. The Community Board had written to the Chairman of the Village Hall Committee requesting that some match funding would be required and asked for substantiation of why an industrial grade oven was required.
- Transport for Bucks (TfB) had been carrying out a considerable amount of remedial works on local roads.
- 23/02/05 Minutes of Parish Council meeting held on 9 January 2023. It was resolved that the draft minutes were a true and accurate record and the Chairman was duly authorised to sign them on behalf of the Council,
- 23/02/06 Clerk's Report: This section provides updates on on-going issues. Resolutions cannot be passed on items in this section.
 - 2 large Pot holes in Watery Lane. Reported (Ref TfB379655391 (18 Nov 21)
 - Gutters and pavements in Lower End. TfB to organise for vegetation to be edged out along pathway (Nov 21) TfB carried out clearance both on the footway and carriageway. (5 Sep 22). Completed 24 Jan 23, but not the pathway between Polish War Memorial and Gravel path. Cllr Town to talk to TfB.
 - c) Failure of footpath at Lower End towards Marsworth Airfield -The total length of footway between the airfield and the entrance to Aspens Farm is about 130 metres which is outside the scope of routine maintenance and would be added to similar schemes to be considered when capital funding was made available for footway surfacing / reconstruction full repair.
 - d) Faded 30mph sign and 30 mph sign hidden in bushes leading from Pitstone to Marsworth TfB had written to the landowner re hedges and TfB would order a replacement for the faded sign (12 August 2022). Replacement Signs now in place 13 Feb 23.
 - e) Bridge Weight Restriction obscured at Red Lion Bridge. TfB has contacted relevant land owners requesting necessary maintenance be carried out in accordance with the Highways Act 1980 (31 Aug 22)
 - The Crescent junction with LIW potholes reported 13 Jan 23 TfB478420648. TfB inspected the area and assessment is that no urgent action is required. TFB will contact Streetscene to arrange for this location to be swept (26 Jan 23)
 - Stepnells near No 5 potholes reported 13 Jan 23 TfB478422425.TfB inspected no action required 24 Jan.
 - Ship Lane junction by Red Lion Bridge reported 13 Jan 23 TfB478423016
 - Vicarage Gardens junction with Vicarage Road potholes at t junction and pavement also failed at junction TfB478423686. TFB inspected no action required 23 Jan 23
 - Church lane junction with Vicarage Road and by 'Townfield potholes where road is failing reported 13 Jan j) 23 TfB478424423
 - Vicarage Road leading from Church down to Red Lion pub. Road failing. Reported 13 Jan 23 TfB478424787
 - Flooding issue on White Lion Bridge water not draining into gulley. Reported 15 Jan 23. TfB478646014.
 - m) 10 Lukes Lea hedgerow has now been cut back to boundary by resident.
 - Street Lights faulty lights at 2 Stepnells, opposite 38 Lukes Lee, 2 Vicarage Gardens and 10 The Crescent. Forde & McHugh have repaired all - Jan 21.
 - o) Private Light, Lower Icknield Way, outside Startops Farm (by the bollard) not working. Repaired by Buckinghamshire as bollards and light managed by Buckinghamshire and the roadway by Hertfordshire.
 - Re-Wilding of 2 small grass verges along Vicarage Road liaison with Community Board on-going.
 - Buckinghamshire Council is conducting a Settlement Review of all Towns and Parishes within the Council area. Parish Clerk completed the form.

Hybrid application (with access details of two main access points from Bulbourne Road and Station road in full and the main development on the rest of the site in outline with all matters reserved) for the demolition of all existing buildings on the site and the development of up to 1,400 dwellings (including up to 140 use class C2 dwellings); a new local centre and sports /community hub, primary school, secondary school, and public open spaces including creation of a suitable alternative natural green space.—App 9 Apr 22. Refused 10 Oct 22. Redrow has produced a 200 plus page report challenging Dacorum's rejection of its application and will be represented at the Appeal hearing by a Planning Kings Counsel and his Junior plus 16 Expert Witnesses. Hearing Appeal commences 7 March 2023.

Outline Planning permission for demolition of existing buildings, structures and hardstanding to enable the erection of up to 320 residential (Use Class C3), a primary school, a local centre comprising community facilities (Use Class F2) and a rural enterprise hub (Use Class E) together with a transport mobility hub, public open space, drainage, landscaping and ancillary infrastructure. New vehicular and pedestrian access off Long Marston Road with all other matters (including other means of access) reserved. MPC objected. Over 200 objections. Application withdrawn. It would appear that the developers, Ainscough Land Securities, will be submitting a new planning application in 2023.
